PROPOSAL:


To vary the required front yard setback from 50 ft to 35 ft for a proposed multi-bay commercial building on a 1.24 acre parcel zoned 'I' Industrial.

REASON:

Proponent wishes to construct a multi-bay commercial building on the parcel. The proposed siting is within the required front yard setback for the parcel.

ZONING:

Industrial

If you cannot attend but would like to make a representation, you may file a written submission in person or via email with the Rural Municipality of Hanover prior to the public hearing. What happens at the public hearing?

At the time and date noted on the reverse of this page, the proposed application will be presented to Council. Council can ask the applicant questions about their application and they will then provide an opportunity for anyone to speak either for or against the application. Please keep presentations to no more than 5 minutes in length.
