_____ Swimming pools must be surrounded by a non-climbable fence at least five (5) feet high which have a self latching gate.

_____ Hot tubs must have a lockable cover with the ability to hold the weight of an adult human walking across it.

_____ Hot tubs and swimming pools must meet the required zoning setbacks for accessory structures in the zone they are located. However, in zones where the required setback is less than 5 ft, they may not come any closer than 5 ft to any property line.

_____ A pool capable of holding 24 inches or more of water requires a permit and may not be used until inspected.

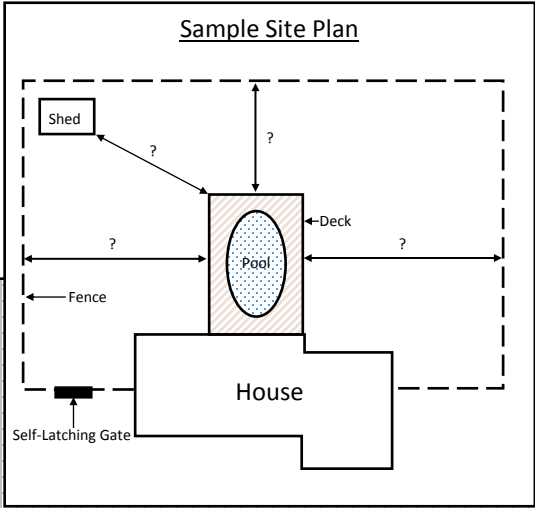
_____ I acknowledge that I am responsible to pay a fee of \$100 for each re-inspection required if the first inspection is failed .

- Pool permit applications which include decks must be accompanied by an open deck checklist.
- Applications for in-ground pools must be accompanied by engineered drawings.

Site Plan

Your site plan must indicate:

- 1. Location of the pool and/or hot tub.
- 2. Location of your fence and self latching gates (pools only).
- 3. The distance from your pool to each property line (no closer than 5 feet) and the house.
- 4. The location of any decks and sheds.
