The intent of this application is to permit a contractor's establishment on 23095 PR 311.

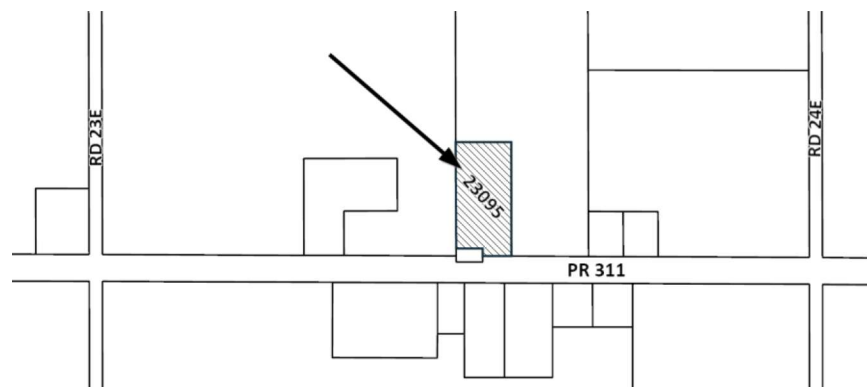
Why was this application submitted?

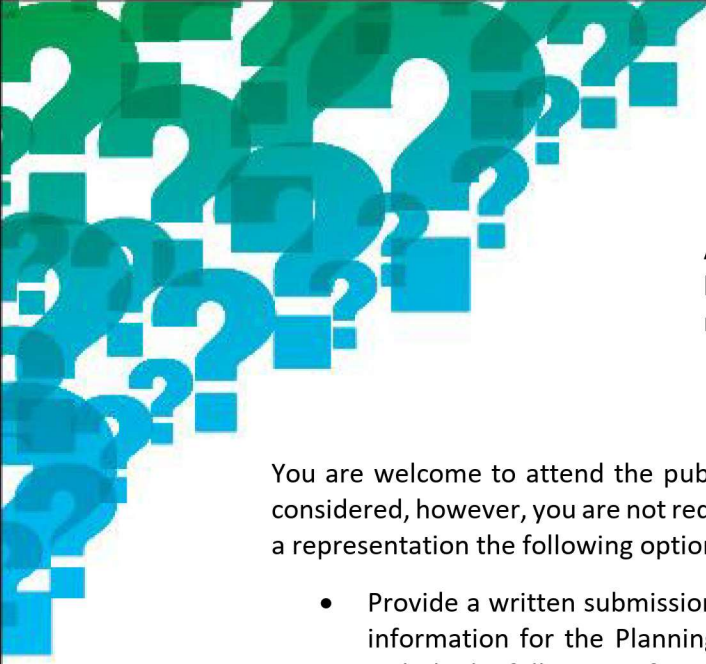

You are welcome to attend the public hearing to make a representation on the matter to be considered, however, you are not required to attend. If you cannot attend but would like to make a representation the following options are available:

- Provide a written submission by email, mail, or fax prior to the public hearing. Contact information for the Planning Department is listed below. Written submissions **must** include the following information:
 - Application Number
 - Name
 - Physical address, and mailing address if different
 - Clearly state your position regarding the request
- Attending the meeting virtually by emailing planning@hanovermb.ca no later than 12:00pm the day prior to the hearing to be provided with the meeting link.

What happens at the public hearing?

At the time and date noted on the reverse of this page, the proposed application will be presented to Council. Council can ask the applicant questions about their application and they will then provide an opportunity for anyone to speak either for or against the application. Please keep presentations to no more than 5 minutes in length.
