CHANGES, ADDITIONS or CLARIFICATION

Clarification – Section II – Tender Form – “Garbage Collection + Processing”

The RM of Hanover wishes to clarify “Section II – Tender Form – Garbage Collection + *Processing*”. The correct statement should read “**Garbage Collection + Transportation**”.

The Contractor's bid price is to include all costs associated with the **collection and transportation** of residential curbside garbage materials, to the designated disposal facility. Garbage collected through the residential curbside collection program is to be transported to the City of Steinbach landfill.

Landfill tipping/disposal fees are not to be included in the Contractor's bid price. The R.M. of Hanover will remain responsible for and will pay the applicable tipping/disposal fees charged by the City of Steinbach landfill. Bidders are to provide pricing for the **collection and transportation services** only.

Clarification – Section V – Equipment for Community Compost Depot Collection

The RM of Hanover wishes to remove the “Equipment for Community Compost Depot Collection” table from Section V entirely. There are no Community Compost Depots that are to be included in the tender and this should not have been included. Only the weekly residential compost collection services of curbside automated bins (within the LUD boundaries) between Spring and Fall are included in this tender as written under “Scope of Work”.

Addition – Definition, Conditions and Specifications

The RM of Hanover wishes to add the following specification:

16) The Contractor shall be responsible for collecting materials (garbage, recycling or compost) located inside the designated curbside collection bin only. The Contractor is not required to collect any additional materials, bags, or items placed beside, on top of, or adjacent to the curbside collection bin.

The Contractor shall use reasonable discretion when attempting to lift or empty a curbside collection bin where the weight of the bin and its contents may exceed the applicable equipment or vehicle weight limitations. The Contractor shall not be required to collect a bin were doing so may exceed established weight limits or create an unsafe condition.

A note or sticker on the affected bin or bin(s) is acceptable to educate the resident but not required. The Contractor shall make the R.M of Hanover staff aware of any missed collections due the above noted reasons.

Bidders are required to acknowledge receipt of Addendum No.1 by signing and submitting with their tender submission.
